



**BAYOU RIFLES, INC.**  
**2021 HP Regional and EIC Match Program**  
**October 1-3, 2021**

**Location:** The George I. Huffman Memorial Range (Bayou Rifles) has 23 firing points at the 200, 300, 600, 800, 900 & 1000 yard lines. It is located approx. 25 miles south of Houston. Take TX Hwy. 288 south, cross TX Hwy 6, proceed 2.6 miles to Brazoria County Rd. 57 West. Turn right (west) and travel 1.8 miles. The range is on the right side (north) of the road. **Schedule: Team Match – 4 Man Teams – 50 Shot NMC with Sighters**

Friday Oct 1, 2021

7:30 - Registration Closes

7:45 - Pits Seal

8:00 - Firing Begins

Course of Fire: 50-shot National Match Course for each team member - with SIGHTERS

Stage 1 - 200 yd Slow Fire Offhand – 2 Sighters + 10 shots per team member, 27-minute block time / pair of team members, infiltration or pair firing allowed.

Stage 2 - 200 yd rapid fire sitting – 2 Sighters + 10 shots rapid fire for record, 60 seconds per string.

Stage 3 - 300 yd rapid fire prone – 2 Sighters + 10 shots rapid fire for record, 70 seconds per string.

Stage 4 - 600 yd slow fire prone – 2 Sighters + 20 shots / team member, 47-minute block time / pair of team members, infiltration or pair firing allowed

Stage 4 may be fired at 300 yards if winds exceed 20 MPH. There is danger of targets breaking off and hitting pit personnel. If this is necessary, the MR-63 target will be used.

Match 9 - Aggregate of stages 1-4 for All Team Members

Match 1 - 200 yd slow fire offhand, 2 sighters + 20 shots for record, 22 minutes

Match 2 - 200 yd rapid fire sitting, 2 sighters + 2 ten-shot strings, 60 seconds per string

Match 3 - 300 yd rapid fire prone, 2 sighters + 2 ten-shot strings, 70 seconds per string

Match 4 - 600 yd slow fire prone, 2 sighters + 20 shots for record, 22 minutes

Match 4 may be fired at 300 yards if winds exceed 20 MPH. There is danger of targets breaking off and hitting pit personnel. If this is necessary, the MR-63 target will be used.

Match 5- Slow Fire Aggregate (Matches 1 and 4)

Match 6 – Rapid Fire Aggregate (Matches 2 and 3)

Match 7 - Aggregate of matches 1-4

**EIC MATCH (50 shots, no sighters)**

Stage 1 - 200 yd slow fire offhand, 10 shots for record, 10 minutes

Stage 2 - 200 yd rapid fire sitting, 1 ten-shot string, 60 seconds

Stage 3 - 300 yd rapid fire prone, 1 ten-shot string, 70 seconds  
Stage 4 - 600 yd slow fire prone, 20 shots for record, 20 minutes  
Match 8 - Aggregate of stages 1-4

Eligibility: Open - NRA Membership Desired but not required.

Entries: Range Capacity is 92 shooters. Advance entries will be given preference. There will be no rain-delay dates for these matches. Pre-registration fees will be returned in the case of match cancellation. All fees will be returned if you cancel via email or phone by 6:00 PM on Wed, September 29, 2021. Registration closes at 7:30 AM the day of the match. YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED UNTIL ENTRY FEES ARE RECEIVED. All registration is via E-Registration. Payment is via credit card only. See the end of the match program a link to the E-Registration.

Registration: All registrations are via E-Registration. Credit card payment is required unless special arrangements are made with the Match Director.

#### CHALLENGES/PROTESTS:

A fee of \$2 will be charged for each challenge, which will be returned if the challenge is met. All competitors are advised to check their posted scores after the completion of a match.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle and CMP rules will govern. Competitors are responsible for the knowing the contents of all current rules. Competitors will score, work target pits, and assist range personnel as required. Competitors may provide qualified pullers with approval of the match director. The match director reserves the right to modify the course of fire and/or pit rotations based on the number of shooters, weather, and range conditions.

Level Loading Rule: The rifle must be pointed at the ground or impact berm when closing the bolt. The 1<sup>st</sup> violation for the day will result in a warning. Any further violations will result in disqualification from the match.

Chamber Flags: An Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required to be inserted while on Bayou Rifles property except during the preparation period or actual firing (rule 10.1.1). Upon firing the last shot the ECI must be re-inserted and the magazine removed before the competitor gets out of firing position. The rifle must be removed from the firing line with an ECI in place. ECI's are available for purchase.

Step Match: The Regional will be an NRA Step Match. Steps will be awarded per the NRA Rules for the NRA Distinguished Rifleman's Badge Program.

Sighters: 2 Sighters (Match 1-4), No sighters - EIC Match

Targets: SR at 200 yards, SR-3 at 300 yards, MR-1 at 600 yards

Scoring: Competitors will score and perform pit duties. Any competitor failing to perform pit or scoring duties may be disqualified.

Rifles: No Muzzle Breaks allowed.

1. NRA Match Rifle (rules 3.3(a-e) - Matches 1-7, not allowed for Match 8 (EIC MATCH). Match rifles with optical sights will compete with match rifles with metallic sights and will be eligible for match and place awards.
2. Service Rifle - Rules 3.1(a-e) - Matches 1-8

Ammunition: No bullet with a diameter greater than 308 inch will be allowed. 55 grain .223 is not allowed at 600 yards. Tracer, incendiaries, armor piercing ammo is not permitted. Ammunition must safe. Bullets must remain supersonic at the target and the match director will have right to remove the competitor/ammunition from the line if the bullet is not supersonic. Any ammo that repeatedly blows primers or splits cases will be

ruled defective or unsafe and the competitor/ammunition will be removed from the firing line. Any competitor that cannot stay on target will be removed from the firing line. The match director can remove any competitor from the firing line if he rules the rifle, ammo or competitor is unsafe.

**Coaching:** Coaching is allowed in Team Match, Coaching not allowed in matches 1-8.

**Challenge Period:** The challenge period will be 30 minutes after the completion of each match. All awards and scores are tentative until publication of the official match bulletin. A jury will resolve protests.

**Awards:** Awards will be given for placing in each category (Match Rifle and Service Rifle) and class. There must be 3 or more entries in a class/category to establish a class/category. If there are fewer than 3 entries in a category (service rifle or match rifle) they will be combined with the other category in the same class. If there are still fewer than 3 entries after combining both categories in a class, there will be no category awards in that class. All competitors will be moved back to their respective categories and combined with the next higher class, until a minimum of 3 competitors is achieved in the combined class. Combining of classes will start at the lowest class that does not have enough entries to establish that class. If the Master Class has insufficient entries to establish a class, it shall be combined upward into the HM class. The HM Class cannot be combined downward to any other established class.

**Match 1,2,3,4 (Individual Matches)**

Winner – \$10  
1st in class - \$10 (min of 4 shooters)  
2nd in class - \$8 (min of 7 Shooters)  
3rd in class – \$6 (min of 10 Shooters)

**Match 7 (Overall AGG)**

Winner - \$20  
1st in class - \$15 (min of 4 shooters)  
2nd in class -\$12 points (min of 7 Shooters)  
3rd in class - \$10 points (min of 10 Shooters)

MATCH 5, 6 (Slow Fire/Rapid Fire AGGs)  
WINNER – \$15 (min of 10 shooters)  
2<sup>nd</sup> SF/RF AGG – \$10 (min of 20 Shooters)  
3<sup>rd</sup> SF/RF AGG – \$5 (min of 30 Shooters)

**MATCH 8 (EIC MATCH)**

CMP will issue medals and award EIC Points.

**Match 9 (TEAM MATCH)**

1<sup>st</sup> – \$40 or 25% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 2 Teams)  
2<sup>nd</sup> – 15% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 4 Teams)  
3<sup>rd</sup> – 10% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 7 Teams)
